AND WHEREAS. The State Board of Health, recognizing the importance of observing a Health Week, and acting in cooperation with such Federation of Women's Clubs and the Minnesota Public Health Association, having requested the appointment of the week beginning November 29th, 1914, for the purpose of a Health Week;

THEREFORE, I, Adolph O. Eberhart, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim and set aside said week beginning November 29th, 1914, as

HEALTH WEEK

and hereby specifically request and urge the clergy through, the state to make Sunday, November 29th, a day for special consideration of health problems, and also urge that the mayors of the various municipalities, all civic and commerce associations, boards of health, departments of education, and other local organizations throughout the state, give all possible assistance in the consideration of health problems during this week.
