

ORDINANCE NO. 54

An Ordinance Annexing Land to the Village of  
Spring Grove, Houston County, Minnesota

The Village Council of the Village of Spring Grove,  
Houston County, Minnesota, ordains:

1:- The following described real estate situate in  
the County of Houston and State of Minnesota, is hereby declared  
to be annexed and added to the Village of Spring Grove in Houston  
County, Minnesota, and to be included within said village, to-wit:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest  
Quarter of Section 12, Township 101 North, Range 7 West  
of the Fifth Principal Meridian lying South of the right  
of way of Minnesota Trunk Highway 44 described as follows,  
to-wit:  
Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Section 12,  
running thence South a distance of 33 feet, thence South  
89 degrees 23 minutes East a distance of 234.01 feet,  
thence North a distance of 66 feet to a concrete monument,  
thence North a distance of 904.7 feet to a concrete monument,  
on the southerly boundary line of the right of way of  
Minnesota Trunk Highway 44, thence Southwesterly along the  
southerly boundary line of said right of way on a 6 degree  
25 minute curve a chord distance of 72.07 feet to a con-  
crete monument, thence Southwesterly along the southerly  
boundary line of said right of way on a 6 degree 25 minute  
curve a chord distance of 166.3 feet to a concrete monument,  
thence Southwesterly along the southerly boundary line of said  
right of way a distance of 8.1 feet to the West line of  
said Section 12, thence South along said section line a  
distance of 892.9 feet to the point of beginning.

2:- This ordinance becomes effective upon its passage  
and publication as provided by law.
