A PROCLAMATION FOR DEFENSE TRANSPORTATION DAY

WHEREAS, the development of the United States and the expansion of its trade and commerce both within the country and with other nations depends upon the continuance of our excellent system of transportation; and

WHEREAS, upon this transportation network our ability to meet a national emergency or defend our country depends in large measure; and

WHEREAS, maintenance of an effective defense system is of prime importance to the citizens of the United States;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 16, 1957, as

DEFENSE TRANSPORTATION DAY

in Minnesota and urge all citizens of the state to greater awareness of the importance of our transportation system both in times of peace and times when a national defense effort is needed.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed this first day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-seven and of the state, the one-hundredth.
