- 1. That the very activities and traditions that make the Christmas holiday season most enjoyable also create safety hazards; and
 - 2. That the Minnesota Judicial Center of Courtesy is sponsoring a "Drive-It-Safe-Christmas" campaign December 11-13; and
 - 3. That newspaper, radio and television releases on such practices for driving and parking on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day will be sent to all news media in the state and special tags explaining safe Christmas practices are to be distributed to all fire lots in Minnesota; and
 - 4. That special bulletins will be issued to cover qualifications and other safety factors;
