

Ordinance No. 79

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOLEY, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Village boundaries of the Village of Foley are hereby extended so as to include the following described parcels of land in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), abutting upon said Village, to-wit:

(a.) Beginning at the intersection of the westerly boundary of Broadway in the Village of Foley with the North line of Section Thirty-five (35); thence extending said westerly boundary of Broadway in a southeasterly direction a distance of 94.95 feet to a point; thence deflecting to the right 90 degrees 45 minutes a distance of 168.6 feet to a point; thence deflecting to the right 89 degrees 44 minutes a distance of 187.2 feet to intersect the North line of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Thirty-seven (37) North, Range Twenty-nine (29) West; Thence Easterly along the North line of said Section Thirty-five (35) a distance of 191.8 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.6 acres, more or less, now of record in the names of Walter E. Swanson and Mildred L. Swanson, husband and wife, as joint tenants and not as tenants in common.

(b.) Commencing at a point 245.3 feet East and 33 feet South of the intersection of the center line of Broadway in the Village of Foley with the North line of said Section Thirty-five (35); said point being the point of beginning; thence Southerly and at right angles to the north section line 110 feet to a point; thence deflecting to the right at a delta angle of 90 degrees for a distance of 168.8 feet to a point; thence deflecting to the right at a delta angle of 62 degrees for a distance of 124.6 feet to intersect with the south right-of-way line of State Aid Road No. 4; thence Easterly along the South right-of-way line of State Aid Road No. 4 for a distance of 227.3 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.5 acres, more or less, now of record in the names of Joseph R. Fischer and Elizabeth Fischer, husband and wife, as joint tenants and not as tenants in common.

(c.) A tract of land about ten feet in width described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of said Section Thirty-five (35), 191.8 feet west of the intersection of said section line with the westerly line of Broadway (Being the northwesterly corner of the tract described in Paragraph (a.) above); thence westerly along said section line 168.2 feet; thence southeasterly and parallel with said west line of Broadway a distance of 11.5 feet; thence easterly and parallel with said section line a distance of 168.2 feet to the northwesterly line of the tract described in Paragraph (a.) above; thence northwesterly and parallel with said west line of Broadway a distance of 11.5 feet to the point of beginning; being a tract of land deeded to the Village of Foley to become part of a village street.
