EXECUTIVE ORDER

A PROCLAMATION FOR ALIEN ADDRESS REPORT DUTY

- WHEREAS, the Immigration and Nationality Act of 1952 requires that every alien in the United States, except diplomats, persons officially connected with international organizations of which the United States is a member, and others admitted temporarily as agricultural laborers, must report his address during January of each year; and
 - WHEREAS, this law requires such an address report through the address of the alien has not changed since the last address report; and
 - WHEREAS, address report cards may now be obtained at any United States post office or immigration service office;
- I, **FRANK B. ROWEN**, I, **Cyrille L. Drewes**, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of January 1958 as

ALIEN ADDRESS REPORT MONTH

In Minnesota and request all citizens, employees and officers of the State of Minnesota to assist and encourage every alien within the State of Minnesota to report his address at the nearest post office or immigration service office during the month of January 1958.
