A Proclamation for Minnesota Beauty Salon Week

  - WHEREAS, This program has contributed immeasurably to the physical and mental well-being of over a million patients in such institutions in recent years and has received praise and recognition from the medical profession for its great therapeutic value; and
  - WHEREAS, This profession offers unlimited opportunities for creative careers to the youth of America;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 9 - 15, 1958, as

and urge all Minnesota citizens to give due recognition to the hairdressers and cosmetologists of Minnesota whose services are dedicated to the service of the women of our state.
