

WEST OF ELECTION TO FILL VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF PEPRESENTATIVES FROM THE FIRST CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT OF THE STATE OF HINTESOTA, AND OF SPECIAL PRIMARY MESCITON TO NOMINATE CAMBIDATES FOR SAID OFFICE.

TO THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, ARE PARTICULARLY OF THE PIRST CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT OF SAID STATE; TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF HIPPESOTA; TO THE COUNTY AUDITORS OF THE COUNTIES OF RICE, GOODHUE, MARASHA, WASECA, STEELE, DODGE, OLMSTED, MINOMA, PRESECTE, HOMER, FILLMORE AND HOUSTON IN SAID STATE; TO ALL ELECTION OFFICIALS OF SAID FIRST CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT AND OF THE SEVERAL ELECTION DISTRICTS THEREIN, AND TO ALL OTHERS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, GREETINGS:

THEREAS, the United States House of Representatives, by official notice from the Clerk of the House, has declared that a vacancy exists in the office of Representative from the First Congressional District of the State of Minnesota; and

UHERRAS, the Congress of the United States is now in session, and the person elected to fill said vacancy will have occasion to exercise the functions of said office immediately after his election;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Grville L. Freeman, as Governor of the State of Hinnesota, acting under the authority and direction of Article I, section 2 of the United States Constitution and Minnesota Statutes 1953, section 205.06, do hereby direct that a special election to fill said vacancy be held in said district on Tuesday, the 18th day of February, 1958, and that a special primary election for the nomination of candidates for said office be held in said district on Tuesday, the 11th day of February, 1950; that the affidavits of candidates for nomination at said primary be filed not later than the seventh day before said primary; that notices of said election and of said special primary election, the nomination of election of candidates and the conduct of said elections be had and all things pertaining thereto be done as provided by Minnesota Statutes 1953, chapters 200 to 211, inclusive, and other applicable provisions of law.

IN HITNESS THEREOF, I have hercunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight and of the state, the one hundredth.
