

Village on December 9th, 1957.


The original of said Ordinance is on file in my office; the same

ORDINANCE NO. 20

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN LANDS BOUNDING THE VILLAGE OF LAKE ELMO ON THE EAST BELONGING TO NORMAN JONDE, ET AL, ANNEXED TO SAID VILLAGE.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF LAKE ELMO ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village Council has determined and hereby does determine that the annexation of the territory hereinafter described will be to the best interests of said Village and of the territory affected.

Section 2. The Petition of Norman Jonde, et al, dated October 31st, 1957, on file in the office of the Village Clerk, to have the following tract of land, situated in East Oakdale Township, Washington County, Minnesota, viz:

All that part of Government Lot One (1) Section Twenty-four (24), Township Twenty-nine (29) North, Range Twenty-one (21) West described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the north line of said Section Twenty-four (24), 993.5 feet west from the northwest corner of the Northeast quarter (NE_{1/4}) of said Section; running thence east along the north line of said Section, 365 feet to a point; running thence South at right angles 262.05 feet to a point; running thence West at right angles 145 feet to a point; running thence South at right angles 1057.95 feet to a point; running thence West 220 feet to the east line of the Village of Lake Elmo; running thence North along said east line of said Village 200 feet; running thence East at right angles 175 feet to a point; running thence North at right angles 45.375 feet to a point; running thence West at right angles 175 feet to the east line of said Village; running thence North along the east line of said Village to the point of beginning.

included within the Village of Lake Elmo, Minnesota, and it appearing that said tract of land abuts the Village on the East, is not included in any other City or borough, is unplatte, does not exceed 200 acres and is suitably conditioned as property to be subjected to Village Government and that said Petition has been signed by the owners of all of said tract of land, is hereby granted and the above described territory is hereby annexed to the Village of Lake Elmo, Minnesota.
