A Proclamation for Minnesota Go to Church Month

WHEREAS, the American Legion has instituted an annual national campaign to get every American closer to God through a "Back to God Movement," and further by accomplishing "Four Chaplains' Day" by a "Go to Church Campaign,"

WHEREAS, the Chaplains of the American Legion, along with other workers from the many posts and districts, as well as the department level have gathered here today to launch their annual drive through a "Cavalcade of Religion," carrying word to every part of our great state, and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of every person in the State of Minnesota to work toward a better life, not only for himself but for his neighbor and the brotherhood of man is only meaningful when viewed in relation to the Fatherhood of God;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1958 as

GO TO CHURCH MONTH

and express the hope that all citizens will cooperate with the Legion in this important program. I am entrusting to those many Chaplains copies of this proclamation to be carried to all corners of the State of Minnesota and to be published in our many newspapers and periodicals, and further, a copy to be presented to the mayors of municipalities of the state, and request those civic officials to lend their aid by making public their own official proclamation in this our commitment.
