A Proclamation for Minnesota Go to Church Month

WHEREAS, the American Legion has initiated an annual national campaign to get every American closer to God through a "God to God Movement," and further by establishing "Pew Captain's Day" by a "Go to Church Campaign."

WHEREAS, the Chaplains of the American Legion, along with other workers from the many posts and districts, as well as the department level have gathered here today to launch their annual drive through a "Standard of Religion," extending word to every part of our great state, and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of every person in the State of Minnesota to work toward a better life, not only for himself but for his neighbor and the brotherhood of man is only strengthened when visited in relation to the fellowship of God;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1958 as

GO TO CHURCH MONTH

and express the hope that all citizens will cooperate with the Legion on this important program. I am directing to be made copies of this proclamation to be carried to all agents of the State of Minnesota and to be published in our many newspapers and periodicals, and further, a copy to be presented to the leaders of Christianity of the state, and request these civic leaders to lend their aid by making public their own official proclamation in their own communities.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital this eighteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight and of the state, the one hundredth.
