

A Proclamation for "Green Right Week"

WHEREAS, there has been an increased awakening on the part of the general public throughout the nation that proper dress is fundamental to our business and social progress; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the textile and apparel industries play an extremely important part in the economy and well-being of our country, giving employment to large numbers of people; and

WHEREAS, dress which is in good taste, attractive and well kept goes a long way toward improving morale, promoting healthy social relations and good citizenship;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Charles L. Freeman, do hereby proclaim the week of April 22, 1958 as

GREEN RIGHT WEEK

and urge all citizens to pay particular attention to their dress for this week and to be governed by the dress requirements recommended by the occasion.
