

A Proclamation for Minnesota Labor-Management Relations Day

WHEREAS, the Minneapolis Junior Chamber of Commerce, through its Labor-Management Relations committee, is conducting the Fourth Annual Labor-Management Relations Forum on March 25, 1958; and

WHEREAS, this Forum program, extending more than a year of preparation and planning, will present the winners of the annual award in the field of labor-management relations to be given to the labor and management representatives for doing an outstanding job in promoting continued good labor-management relations in Minneapolis; and

WHEREAS, the Minneapolis Junior Chamber of Commerce Labor-Management Relations Committee, composed of members of both organized labor and management is dedicated to conduct an active education program which will enlighten the public as to the need for continued good labor-management relations and methods of achieving this goal;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, March 25, 1958, as

MINNESOTA LABOR-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS DAY

and do urge all citizens of Minnesota to recognize the significance of this Labor-Management Relations Forum on helping to make Minnesota a better place in which to live and work.
