

A Proclamation for "Save Your Vision Week"

- WHEREAS, two out of three of our adult citizens depend on vision care to enable them to enjoy full lives; and
- WHEREAS, many neglect such preventive measures as proper lighting and periodic vision examinations; and
- WHEREAS, an increasing proportion of our population is in older age groups especially dependent on the aids of modern science to enjoy healthy vision;

YET, THOMAS E. GARDNER, G. Caville E. Johnson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 2nd to 8th, 1958,

and call upon all Minnesotans to cooperate with this program designed for the health and welfare of our citizens.
