

Ordinance No. 89

An Ordinance Annexing certain land to the Village of Roseau,
Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Roseau, Minnesota, do ordain
as follows:

Section 1. That the following described land, situated, lying and
being in the County of Roseau, and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Lot One (1) of Auditor's Plat No. Thirty-Five (35), of
the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
of Section Fourteen (14), in Township One Hundred Sixty-
Two (162) N., Range Forty (40) West, excepting therefrom
the South Five Hundred Thirty-Two feet (532) of said
Lot One (1) and also excepting the North Eighty (80) feet
of said Lot One (1).,

abutting upon the incorporated Village of Roseau, Minnesota, be and the
same hereby is annexed to said Village, to become a part of said Village
as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and
publication, and the filing of a certified copy thereof with the
Secretary of State of said State of Minnesota.




