

CERTIFIED COPY OF ORDINANCE NO. 130 PASSED AND ADOPTED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FARMINGTON ON THE 10TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1956, DECLARING CERTAIN LAND IN CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP ANNEXED TO THE VILLAGE OF FARMINGTON.

Ordinance No. 130

That the Village Council of the Village of Farmington do hereby certify that the following is a true and correct copy of the ordinance as passed and adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Farmington on the 10th day of February, 1956:

Section 1.

That all of the parcels of land hereinafter described have been within the Village of Farmington at the time that they were last taxed for the Village of Farmington.

Section 2.

That said parcels of land hereinafter described, in conformity with the Village of Farmington, do hereby annexed to the Village of Farmington, and in so doing, do hereby subject to the jurisdiction of the Village of Farmington.

Section 3.

That it is hereby determined that the annexation of said land to the Village of Farmington will be, and is, to the best interests of the Village of Farmington and of the territory affected.

Section 4.

That there is hereby annexed to the Village of Farmington all the land lying and being in the County of Dakota and State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot Three (3) and Four (4) of Mrs. May's Addition according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Lands in and for Dakota County, Minnesota; and the North Half of the Northwest Quarter (3) of Section 12 of Township 52N (3), Range 120E (29), according to the government survey thereof, together with all roads and highways adjoining the premises aforesaid, or either of them; excepting from said premises the four parcels described as follows, to-wit: (1) The North One Hundred Fifty feet (N 150') of the East Seventy Five feet (E 75') of said Lot Three (3); (2) The North One Hundred Fifty feet (N 150') of the West Eighty Three feet (W 83') of said Lot Three (3); (3) The North One Hundred Fifty feet (N 150')

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of the East Fourteen (E 14) rods of said Lot Four (4); and (4) the West Six (W 6) rods of said Lot Four (4).

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies thereof in the office of the County Auditor of Dakota County and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota as required by law.


