KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, MILES LORD, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby, on request of the Industrial Commission, constitute and appoint ROBERT LATZ of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Attorney to act for the State of Minnesota in connection with the disposition of NOTICES of the physically impaired employees and NOTICES of intention to claim reimbursement under Laws 1957, Chapter 908 and matters related thereto, and to serve at my pleasure or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.

The compensation and necessary expenses of the Special Attorney shall be paid by the Industrial Commission out of the special compensation fund, pursuant to verified statements submitted twice a month to the Commission, showing the number of days expended by counsel in the performance of his duties under this appointment, together with a list of work performed or services rendered. The compensation shall be \$40 per day, and counsel shall be reimbursed for expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of his duties.


This commission is to take effect March 10, 1958.




