
Dear Sir:

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

I Certify That, satisfactory evidence having been exhibited of the appointment of
Jan Witki, _____ as Consul of the Polish People's Republic at Washington,
District of Columbia, for all the States and
Territories of the United States, the President of the United States of America has ordered
his recognition as such officer, declaring him free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers, and
privileges as are allowed to Consuls by the law of Nations, and by the laws of the United States.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Herbert Hoover, Jr., Acting Secretary of State
of the United States of America, have hereunto subscribed my name and caused the Seal of the
Department of State to be affixed.

Done at the City of Washington this twelfth day of December in the year
of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six and the 181st year
of the Independence of the United States of America.
