WHEREAS, children who have gained the simple truths taught by the Word of God rarely become swayed by the temptations of our complex society;

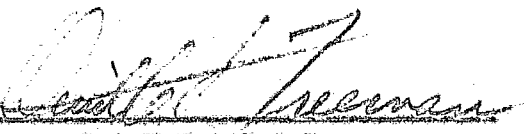
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 20 to April 26 as

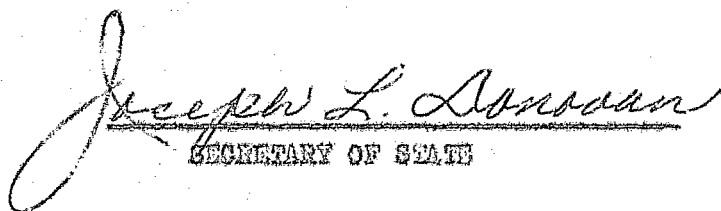

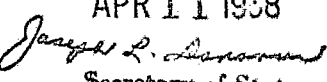
in recognition of the important role it plays in our lives and urge parents and children to worship and learn together in their Sunday School.
