EXECUTIVE ORDER

A PROCLAMATION FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES WEEK

WHEREAS, city, county and state public employees have made an outstanding contribution to safety, health and general welfare in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, our public employees are dedicated to the goal of making Minnesota a better place for all her citizens; and

WHEREAS, Minnesotans are sometimes unaware of the outstanding job being done by our public employees throughout the state and do not fully appreciate its value; and

WHEREAS, public employees over the nation are devoting the first week of June to furthering good will and understanding between public employees and the citizens whom they serve;

I, THEREFORE, I, Orville F. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 1 through June 7, 1958 as

PUBLIC EMPLOYEES WEEK

and call upon all citizens of Minnesota to recognize the work being done each day by these dedicated public employees.
