NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the day of May 19, 1938 as


MINNESOTA CENTENNIAL AMATEUR BOXING DAY


and urge all Minnesotans to support programs which provide the facilities and opportunities for boxing instruction to the youth of our state.
