



ing March 18, 1958, and to serve at the pleasure of the
Attorney General, or until this commission shall be revoked
or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby
fix the compensation of said EDWARD J. PARKER at the sum of
Eight Thousand, Seven Hundred, Seventy-five and no/100 Dollars
(\$8,775.00) per year, to be paid from the appropriation made
for the Department of the Attorney General.

Saint Paul, Minnesota, this 18th day of March, 1958.




