

ORDINANCE NO. 289

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON,
MINNESOTA.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, DO ORDAIN:

NOW, WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 413.14 and all amendments
thereto, of Minnesota Statutes for 1941, all owners of property
hereinafter described and abutting upon the City of Worthington,
have petitioned the City Council of said City of Worthington to
have such property annexed to said City; and

WHEREAS, It is desired that said territory become a part of
said City of Worthington, the same as if it had been originally a
part thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, The following described territory is hereby
declared to be a part of the City of Worthington; to-wit,

That part of the platted property known as Ludlow Acres, lying
in Section 27, Township 102 North, Range 40 West of the 5th P.M.
in the County of Nobles and State of Minnesota, described as follows:

Lots Four (4) and Five (5) Auditor's Plat of Block Seven (7)
Ludlow Acres
Lots Three (3) and Four (4) Auditor's Plat of Block Eight (8)
Ludlow Acres
