






ORDINANCE NO. 1.7001

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF MADOLIA, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LAND.

The Village Council of the Village of Madolia, Minnesota, ordinance

SEC. 1. DECLARATION.

A petition having been filed herein requesting the annexation of the territory described below which petition was duly presented to the Council on May 26, 1958, it is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

SEC. 2. TERRITORY ANNEXED.

The corporate limits of the Village of Madolia, Minnesota are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:

Lots 5 and 6 and the north 115 feet of lots 7 and 8 of Briggara subdivision of lot "G" of the West one-half of the northwest quarter of Section 26, Township 107, Range 30.

SEC. 3. FILING.

The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance in the office of the secretary of state and in the office of the county auditor of Itasca County, Minnesota.

SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ANNEXATION

Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as directed in Sec. 2.
