Be it known that on the 27th day of January, 1958, a petition for the organization of the Wadena Soil Conservation District, signed by more than twenty-five land occupiers was duly filed in the office of the State Soil Conservation Committee;

That on the 4th day of March, 1953, at Wadena, a public hearing was held after due notice of the said hearing had been given as required by law;

That on the 31st day of March, 1958, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, for a soil conservation district to function in the proposed territory and did define the boundaries thereof;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Committee on the question of the creation of the said district;

That the said referendum was held within the defined boundaries on the 21st day of April, 1958.

That the result of the referendum showed that a majority of the votes cast in the said referendum were in favor of the creation of the said district;

That thereafter on the 26th day of May, 1958, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that the operation of the said district is administratively practicable and feasible;
