WHEREAS, on May 11, 1938, the State of Minnesota entered
its second century of statehood, children were
born who became symbols of our hope for peace and
progress; and

WHEREAS, a committee had determined that Minnesota become
a state at 8:27 P. M. on May 11, 1938, and one
child known to that committee was born nearest
that time;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State
of Minnesota do hereby proclaim and designate that child,
Wayne Elton Catron, son of Mr. and Mrs. Catron

FIRST CITIZEN OF THE
SECOND CENTURY OF MINNESOTA STATEHOOD

And in the name of the people of the great State of Minnesota,
I confer upon him the honors of this state and charge him, and
all young people, with the responsibility of upholding the
traditions of the great State of Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have
hereunto set my hand and caused
the Great Seal of the State of
Minnesota to be affixed at the
State Capitol this eighth day
of June in the year of our Lord
one thousand nine hundred and
sixty-eight and of the state,
the one hundred first.
