DECLARATION FOR CIVIL AVIATION USE

WHEREAS, the 25th anniversary of the Civil Aeronautics Administration calls our attention to the vital role that Federal agency has played in developing a safe and dependable national system of air transportation; and

WHEREAS, progress in civil aviation has had a marked effect on Minnesota's one hundred year history, until today we are bound closely with the rest of the country by the nationwide system of airports, air navigation facilities and air transportation services; and

WHEREAS, many groups in our society have contributed to the rapid development of civil aviation, including the airlines, airport operators, aircraft manufacturers, private and business pilots, and the Federal, state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, future progress in air transportation, including the transition to jet-powered transports, will necessitate the continued cooperation among all elements of aviation and CAA personnel throughout the country;

AND, WHEREAS, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of Minnesota, join with governors of the other states in proclaiming the week beginning June 23, 1958, as

CIVIL AVIATION WEEK

as a salute to the Civil Aeronautics Administration and as a call to greater exertion by all to meet the challenge of the future of civil aviation.
