WHEREAS, Minnesotans in record number have made boating their favorite summer recreation; and


WHEREAS, the increasing number of boats on our lakes emphasizes the need for safe boating practices which permit maximum enjoyment for all persons;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning June 29, 1958 as


"MINNESOTA SAFE BOATING WEEK"


