

An ordinance annexing certain lands to village of Nassau.

The Village Council of the village of Nassau ordain as follows:

Section 1, That the following described tract of land to wit-
Beginning at a point thirty (30) feet due west of the south west
corner of block ten (10) in the village of Nassau, County of
Lac Qui Parle, State of Minnesota, thence running due west one
hundred (100) feet, thence running due north one hundred twenty
eight (128) feet, thence running due east one hundred (100) feet,
thence running due south one hundred twenty eight (128) feet to
point of beginning, said land being in the south east corner of
lot four (4) south of the railroad track, in section thirty two (32)
township one hundred nineteen (119) and range forty six (46)
in Lac Qui Parle County, State of Minnesota, abutting upon the
incorporated village of Nassau and the same is hereby annexed
to such village and shall become a part of such village as
effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.
