You are therefore by these presents, appointed and commissioned judge of said district court as aforesaid,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said office of judge of said district court together with all the rights, powers, and emoluments to the said office belonging, or by law in anywise appertaining, until this commission shall be by me or other lawful authority, superseded or annulled, or expire by force or reason of any law of this State.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the Capitol, in the City of Saint Paul, this thirteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred fifty-eight and of the State the one hundred first.
