

ORDINANCE NO. 1.7002
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE
CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE
OF MADELLA, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE
CERTAIN PLATTED LANDS.
THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF MADELLA, MINNESOTA,
ORDAINS:

Section 1. DECLARATION.

A petition having been filed herein requesting the annexation of the territory described below to the Village of Madella, Minnesota, was duly presented to the Village Council on July 14, 1958. Pursuant to notice duly given a public hearing was held on the proposed annexation on August 25, 1958. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 2. TERRITORY ANNEXED.

The corporate limits of the Village of Madella, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:

A. Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 and the North 66 feet of Lot 11 of Driggers subdivision of Lot C of the West one-half of the northwest quarter of Section 26, Township 107, Range 30.

B. Lots 1, (except the west 70 feet of the north 90 feet) 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of Driggers subdivision of the west one-half of the northwest quarter of Section 26, Township 107, Range 30.

Section 3. FILING.

The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State and in the office of the County Auditor of Watonwan County, Minnesota.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ANNEXATION.

Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3.
