







ORDINANCE NO. 1.7003

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF KADOLIA, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CIRCAH PLATTED LAND.

THE VILLAGE CONSISTS OF THE VILLAGE OF KADOLIA, MINNESOTA, ORDAINED:

Section 1. DECLARATION.

A petition having been filed herein requesting the annexation of the territory described below to the Village of Kadolia, Minnesota, was duly presented to the Village Council on July 26, 1958. Pursuant to notice duly given, a public hearing was held on the proposed annexation on August 25, 1958, and it is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the Village of Kadolia, Minnesota, and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 2. TERRITORY EXTENDED.

The corporate limits of the Village of Kadolia, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:

Lot "A" of Gurnsworth's Second Addition to the Village of Kadolia, Minnesota, is the west one-half of the west one-half of the southwest quarter of Section 23, Township 107, Range 30.

Section 3. TITLING.

The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State and in the office of the County Auditor of Watonwan County, Minnesota.

Section 4. TIME AND PLACE OF ANNEXATION.

Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3.
