ORDINANCE NO. 1.7003

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF MADOLIA, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LAND.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADOLIA, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. DECLARATION.

A petition having been filed herein requesting the annexation of the territory described below to the Village of Madolia, Minnesota, was duly presented to the Village Council on July 26, 1958. Pursuant to notice duly given, a public hearing was held on the proposed annexation on August 25, 1958, and it is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the Village of Madolia, Minnesota, and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 2. TERRITORY ANNEXED.

The corporate limits of the Village of Madolia, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:

Lot "A" of Farnsworth's Second Addition to the Village of Madolia, Minnesota, is the west one-half of the west one-half of the southeast quarter of Section 27, Township 107, Range 30.

Section 3. FILING.

The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State and in the office of the County Auditor of Watonwan County, Minnesota.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ANNEXATION.

Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3.
