A Proclamation for "American Education Week"

WHEREAS, the schools of Minnesota, open to every child, are the very life-blood of free government and the cornerstones on which we build for the future;

WHEREAS, sound education is essential to the continuing progress and development of our state and the prosperity of our people;

WHEREAS, true faith in education must be shown by work on its behalf in every community;

NOW, therefore, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do proclaim the week of November 9 - 15, 1958, as

AMERICAN EDUCATION WEEK

and do urge all citizens and organizations to acquaint themselves with the achievements and problems of their own schools, and to encourage their neighbors to do likewise, toward the end that the schools will receive the support and cooperation they require.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight and of the state, the one hundred first.
