

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING  
CERTAIN TRACTS OF LAND  
TO THE VILLAGE OF  
FERTILE

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF  
THE VILLAGE OF FERTILE  
POLK COUNTY, MINNESO-  
TA DO ORDAIN AS FOL-  
LOWS:

That the following described  
tracts of land situated in Polk  
County, Minn.:

A tract of land situated in the  
northeast corner of Section 29  
township 147 north of range 44  
west of the 5th P. M. described  
as follows; starting at a point 40  
feet West and 177.3 feet south  
from the section corner common  
to sections 20-21-28 and 29;  
thence south along the west  
boundary of Highway No. 32 a  
distance of 60 feet; thence de-  
flect right 90 degrees a distance  
of 35 feet to a point 75 feet dis-  
tant from center line of State  
Highway No. 32; thence south  
along the West boundary of  
Highway 100.7 feet to a point 75  
feet distant from center line of  
highway No. 32; thence due west  
a distance of 105 feet; thence  
due north parallel to the section  
line between sections 28 & 29 a  
distance of 160.7 feet; thence  
due east a distance of approxi-  
mately 165 feet to the starting  
point on the west boundary of  
Highway No. 32.
