NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the following resolution:

Be it resolved that all citizens of Minnesota within the sound of KQEA-TV's video recognize the great value of educational television and the necessity for providing supplementary funds for its maintenance, and that they contribute "A Dollar or Two for Channel 8".
