WHEREAS, the solution to the grave problem of traffic accidents and deaths will be found only in vigorous leadership on local, state and national levels in conjunction with wholehearted cooperation of all citizens; and


WHEREAS, the cause of traffic mishaps which can easily be corrected is the operation of defective and improperly maintained vehicles;

ANNE HENRICKSEN, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1950, as


AUTOMOBILE INSPECTION AND REPAIR MONTH
