WHEREAS, all channels of communication must be utilized to achieve better mutual understandings; and


WHEREAS, contact between individuals by letter is an especially effective means of communication for nations as well;

I, ORVILLE L. FREEMAN, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of October 6 - 13, 1968 as


"INTERNATIONAL WRITER WEEK"

In Minnesota and urge all citizens of the state to write letters to friends in other nations and thus act as ambassadors of good will among nations.


