PROCLAMATION

MINNESOTA VOLUNTEER FIREMEN DAY

WHEREAS, Minnesota's volunteer firemen each year perform valiant service to their communities through applying in the prevention and control of fires; and

WHEREAS, they are of invaluable assistance in educating Minnesota to the means of preventing unnecessary economic and human loss through fires; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that during Fire Prevention Week which begins October 5th, we recognize this service by setting aside a special day for the tribute to Minnesota's Volunteer Firemen;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the day of Saturday, October 3, 1959, as

MINNESOTA VOLUNTEER FIREMEN DAY

and urge all citizens to honor their volunteer firemen for the fine job they are doing and to cooperate with them for the benefit of themselves and their fellow citizens.
