ORDINANCE NO. 91

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF ROSEAU, MINNESOTA.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ROSEAU, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described land, situated, lying and being in the County of Roseau, and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

All that part of Subdivision "E" of Riverside Subdivision, according to the recorded plat thereof, which lies Westerly of the public highway known as Riverside Avenue (but not officially designated as such) EXCEPTING THEREFROM the South Fifty (50) feet, of even width, thereof, AND the South Ten (10) feet, of even width, of that part of Subdivision "D" of Riverside Subdivisions, according to the recorded plat thereof, which lies Westerly of the public highway known as Riverside Avenue (but not officially designated as such), all being in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, of Sec. 13, in Twp. 162 N., Range 40 W., and that said described land contained less than 200 acres,

abutting upon the incorporated Village of Roseau, Minnesota, be and the same hereby is annexed to said Village, to become a part of said Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, and the filing of a certified copy thereof with the Secretary of State of said State of Minnesota.
