





**ORDINANCE NO. 1.7101
AN ORDINANCE DETACHING CERTAIN
TERRITORY FROM THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF MADEIRA,
MINNESOTA.
THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF MADEIRA, MINNESOTA,
ORDAINS:**

Section 1. DECLARATION. A petition by the owner of the real estate hereinafter described requesting that said territory be detached from the corporate limits of the Village of Madeira, Minnesota, having been filed with the village clerk, was duly presented to the Village Council on September 22, 1958. It was made to appear that the territory described therein is an unplatted tract of farm land situated within the corporate limits of the Village of Madeira adjacent to the village boundary and is occupied and used solely for agricultural purposes and that the said lands may be detached from the Village of Madeira without unreasonably affecting the geographical area of the settled portion of the Village of Madeira.

Section 2. TERRITORY DETACHED. The corporate limits of the Village of Madeira, Minnesota, are hereby amended by detaching from the corporate limits the following described territory:

The West one-half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 107, Range 30, excepting therefrom the railroad right-of-way and excepting therefrom the following described tract of land:
Beginning at the Southeast corner of the West one-half of the southwest quarter of Section 22, Township 107, Range 30, thence west for a distance of 70 feet, thence north to the right-of-way of the Chicago, St. Paul, Minneapolis and Omaha Railroad, thence in a general easterly direction along the right-of-way of said railroad to the east line of said west one-half of the southwest quarter of Section 22, thence south along said east line to the point of beginning.

Section 3. FILING. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State and in the office of the county auditor of Watonwan County, Minnesota.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE OF DETACHMENT. Detachment of said territory shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3.
