A PROCLAMATION FOR "COLUMBUS DAY"

WHEREAS, Columbus' great discovery of October 12, 1492, marks the beginning of extensive exploration of the western hemisphere; and

WHEREAS, this discovery was the founding of the historic brotherhood of the Americas; and

WHEREAS, the 1958 theme of Columbus Day is "Americans All", emphasizing the unifying of Americans of many creeds, languages and cultures;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 12, 1958 as

"COLUMBUS DAY"

In Minnesota and urge all citizens of the state to better acquaint themselves with the lives and cultures of our neighbors in the hemisphere.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this ninth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight and of the state, the one hundred thirty-eighth.
