WHEREAS, the United States is dedicated to the concepts of liberty and equality; and

WHEREAS, this dedication drew to our country's great numbers of freedom-loving peoples from all parts of the world; and

WHEREAS, those peoples enriched our cultural heritage and enhanced our material welfare with their contributions of ideas and labor, and it is fitting and proper that we be ever-mindful of the heritage left by foreign-born settlers in our state; and

THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 30, 1958 as

"FOREIGN BORN APPRECIATION DAY"

and do urge all Minnesotans toward greater awareness of the contributions to our society made by our foreign-born citizens.
