PROCLAMATION FOR YOUTH HOLIDAY

WHEREAS, the great majority of the youth of the State of Minnesota are law-abiding citizens who make contributions of major significance as like citizens of their respective communities; and

WHEREAS, a small number of delinquent juveniles often come to the attention of the public and reflect unfavorably upon youth as a whole; and

WHEREAS, we should give recognition to those many young people who are assets to society; and

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives of the State of Minnesota, the Senate concurring, have authorized the Governor of the State of Minnesota to issue a proclamation designating October 31 of each year as Youth Honor Day;

BEFORE, THEREFORE, I, Gervill L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 31, 1958, as

YOUTH HONOR DAY

In Minnesota and urge all citizens toward greater realization of the contributions of the young people of the state to our community.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-eighth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight and of the state, the one hundred first.
