

PROCLAMATION FOR VISIT YOUR VA DAY

WHEREAS, the war veterans of the United States of America merit and deserve the gratitude of all of their fellow citizens; and

WHEREAS, November 11, by enactment of the Congress and the will of the President of the United States, has been set apart for national observance as Veterans Day; and

WHEREAS, Senator G. Whittier, Administrator of Veterans Affairs, has declared Monday, November 10, 1958, to be VA Open House Day; and

WHEREAS, the Veterans Administration Center at Fort Snelling, St. Paul, Minnesota, and the Veterans Administration Hospital at 16th Avenue and 5th Street, Minneapolis, organized by law to serve the well-being of veterans, wish to present evidence of their faithfulness to the public trust;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, November 10, 1958 as


VISIT YOUR VA CENTER AND VA HOSPITAL DAY
