PROCLAMATION

Secretary of State

WHEREAS by the enactment of Chapter 922, Laws of 1957, the Legislature proposed an amendment to Article IV, section 9, of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, purporting to be Legislature, for the approval or rejection of the electors of the State at the recent election held on the fourth day of November, 1958, providing that said Article when amended shall read as follows:

"Section 9. No senator or representative shall during the term for which he is elected, hold any other elective office under the authority of the State of Minnesota except that of Notary Public or of the United States except that of postmaster. No senator or representative shall be disqualified for election to any elective office, but any senator or representative who is elected to any elective office under the authority of the state or the United States, who shall qualify for the office to which elected, shall automatically terminate his term of office as senator or representative and create a vacancy therein, provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall preclude any senator or representative from serving as attorney for any school district or political subdivision of the state except that he shall not serve as a county attorney."

AND WHEREAS it appears from the official canvass of the votes cast at said election held on the fourth day of November, 1958 for and against the aforesaid proposed amendment, made in conformity with the law, that a sufficient majority of all electors voting at such election did not vote for its adoption;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me and in compliance with law, do hereby publish and proclaim that said proposed amendment of Article IV, section 9 of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota has been lost.

I WITNESS WHEREBY I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed this twentieth day of November, 1958.
