 - WHEREAS, American community theatres preserve our dramatic heritage through their production of living theatre in a continuous tradition;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim November 1958 as

"AMERICAN COMMUNITY THEATRE MONTH"

in honor and recognition of the community theatre's noble contribution to American culture.
