NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 10 - 16, 1958 as


"YOUTH APPRECIATION WEEK"

and urge every citizen of Minnesota to join in this opportunity to show appreciation toward the youth of our state and their contributions to its communities.


