NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Hennepin, Minnesota:

1. That an election is hereby called and directed to be held on the 2nd day of December, 1958, at the Corcoran Town Hall, located on County Road No. 10 approximately two (2) miles West of its intersection with County Road No. 50, at which election all qualified voters residing within the territory described in said petition may vote for or against the incorporation of said territory as the Village of Corcoran, Minnesota, and the polls at said election shall be open from 10:00 o'clock A.M., until 8:00 o'clock P.M. of said day.

2. George Reinking, Joe Pettit, and William Cain, whose mailing address is Minnesota, and as alternates, William K. Reinking and Theo. Oswald, whose mailing address is Rogers, Minnesota, all being electors residing within said territory, are hereby appointed to be the judges at said election, and they shall conduct the same so far as practicable in accordance with the laws

regulating the election of town officers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the County Auditor cause notice of said election to be given in the manner prescribed by law.


