RESOLUTION OF CONSOLIDATION

WHEREAS, The Village of Triumph is a municipal corporation in Martin County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, The Village of Monterey is a municipal corporation in Martin County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the boundary line of said Village of Triumph is coincident with the boundary line of said Village of Monterey for a considerable distance, and

WHEREAS, it is felt that it would be for the best interest of said Village of Triumph and its inhabitants and that it would serve the public purpose and promote the public good, that said Village of Triumph be consolidated with said Village of Monterey.

YOU THEREFORE, DO IT ENDEAVOR AS FOLLOWS:

(1) That the Village of Triumph, Martin County, Minnesota, and the Village of Monterey, Martin County, Minnesota, be consolidated and the name of the consolidated village be Erinmont.

(2) That the time when such consolidation shall be effective shall be January 1, 1959.

(3) That said consolidated village government shall be set up and operate under "Optional Plan A" as set forth in Minnesota Statutes Annotated Sections 412.501 and 412.501, et. seq., as amended, and shall have two wards; the area contained in the present Village of Monterey shall be known as Ward 1 and the area contained in the present Village of Triumph shall be known as Ward 2; that the boundary line between said Wards as to future additions to said Village, shall be the North-South Section Line between Sections Five and Six (5 & 6) in Fox Lake Township, Martin County, Minnesota, and the North-South Section Line between Sections Thirty One and Thirty Two (31 & 32) in Coloma Township, Martin County, Minnesota.

(4) All incident officers of both Villages shall hold office through December 31, 1958, and that prior to said date, the following officers shall be elected to take office as of January 1, 1959; said officers being: One

mayor for a term of one (1) year, one councilman from Ward 1 for a term of three (3) years, one councilman from Ward 2 for a term of three (3) years, one councilman from Ward 1 for a term of one (1) year, one councilman from Ward 2 for a term of two (2) years, two Justice's of the Peace and two constables.

(5) That the nonconsolidated village assume all obligations and contracts of each of said Villages and acquire all property owned by each of said Villages.


(6) That said consolidated Village have all right, powers and privileges that each of said Villages now possess and to be subject to all duties, obligations and liabilities to which of each said Village is now obligated.

RESOLUTION OF CONSOLIDATION

WHEREAS, The Village of Monterey, is a municipal corporation in Martin County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, The Village of Triumph is a municipal corporation in Martin County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the boundary line of said Village of Monterey is coincident with the boundary line of said Village of Triumph for a considerable distance, and

WHEREAS, it is felt that it would be for the best interest of said Village of Monterey and its inhabitants and that it would serve the public purpose and promote the public good, that said Village of Monterey be consolidated with said Village of Triumph.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, AS IS HEREBY AS FOLLOWS:

(1) That the Village of Monterey, Martin County, Minnesota, and the Village of Triumph, Martin County, Minnesota, be consolidated and the name of the consolidated village be Trimont.

(2) That the time when such consolidation shall be effective shall be January 1, 1969.

(3) That said consolidated village government shall be set up and operate under "Optional Plan A" as set forth in Minnesota Statutes Annotated Sections 412.581 and 412.591, et.seq., as amended, and shall have two wards; the area contained in the present Village of Monterey shall be known as Ward 1 and the area contained in the present Village of Triumph shall be known as Ward 2; that the boundary line between said Wards as to future additions to said Village, shall be the North-South Section Line between Sections Five and Six (5 & 6) in Fox Lake Township, Martin County, Minnesota, and the North-South Section Line between Sections Thirty One and Thirty Two (31 & 32) in Galena Township, Martin County, Minnesota.

(4) All incumbent officers of both Villages shall hold office through December 31, 1968, and that prior to said date, the following officers shall be elected to take office as of January 1, 1969; said officers being: One

mayor for a term of one (1) year, one councilman from Ward 1 for a term of three (3) years, one councilman from Ward 2 for a term of three (3) years, one councilman from Ward 1 for a term of one (1) year, one councilman from Ward 2 for a term of two (2) years, two Justice's of the Peace and two constables.

(5) That the consolidated village assumes all obligations and contracts of each of said Villages and acquires all property owned by each of said Villages.


